Framework	The Procura ⁺ seminar series provides a platform to promote exchange amongst purchasers from all levels of government, suppliers, manufacturers, policy-makers and multipliers on specific topics related to sustainable public procurement.

Main goals / programme themes	The main goal of the seminar will be to identify strategies for mainstreaming low-carbon and innovation procurement in European public authorities.
	The seminar will offer step-by-step guidance for implementation and best practice presentations from leading European public authorities. This includes a range of interactive exchange opportunities as well as tips and tricks for market engagement activities based on the GPP 2020 project's tender model series.
	In particular, the seminar will explore how to successfully combine efforts towards innovation and sustainable procurement and using these synergies to reach strategic climate goals.

Budget / host requirements	 The host is asked to provide: a suitable venue for the Seminar (50-75 seat plenary room, additional 30-seat break-out/meeting room and technical equipment – projectors, screens, microphones, computers), catering for participants (coffee/tea and lunch breaks), language interpretation/translation (if required), compensation for staff costs to organise the event, travel and accommodation for speakers, and materials (badges, programme, participant pack, etc.)





The host's contribution can be negotiated on an individual basis and can either be offered (in kind) by the host organisation or fund-raised

Possible event elements	The Seminar will comprise a variety of elements, aimed at providing exchange and learning opportunities to all participants.
	 Plenaries: presenting the latest information on low-carbon and innovation procurement in Europe including legislation, initiatives and support mechanisms at the EU level
	 Workshops: presenting and discussing good practice cases between suppliers, purchasers and other stakeholders
	 Social events to allow participants to socialise and discuss informally (optional)

The GPP 2020 project aims to mainstream low-carbon procurement across Europe in support of the EU's goals to achieve a 20% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions, a 20% increase in the share of renewable energy and a 20% increase in energy efficiency by 2020.

To this end, GPP 2020 will implement more than 100 low-carbon tenders, which will directly result in substantial CO_2 savings. To date GPP 2020 has saved almost 48,000 tons of CO_2 through public procurement. Moreover, GPP 2020 is running a capacity building programme that includes trainings and exchange. – www.gpp2020.eu
