



Report: 2nd training course, Roma, 15 and 17 September “Low carbon public procurement: opportunities and strategies”

The second training course for public procurers organized by Ecosistemi in Italy was held in Rome, hosted by Region Lazio.

The first session of the training course (15th September) had as main target the mayors of Lazio's municipalities. Representatives of the regional administration explained how Region Lazio intends to develop green public procurement policies, starting from the adherence to the GPP2020 project. Lidia Capparelli explained how Consip is contributing the diffusion of green procurement at national level, while Silvano Falocco from Ecosistemi illustrated the objectives of low carbon procurement at European and national level.

The second session (17th September) focussed on technical contents and main target were:

- Persons in charge of procurement and technicians from the Region Lazio;
- Persons in charge of procurement and interested technicians from local authorities.

Participants learned about strategies for low carbon acquisitions, the legal framework for green procurement, writing tenders with environmental criteria. The Action Plan for Green Public Procurement of the Province of Rome was presented as a case study by Patrizia Giacotti and Sara del Gobbo.
