



## Report: 4th training course, San Giuseppe Vesuviano (Na), 25 and 26 May

### “Low carbon public procurement: opportunities and strategies”

The fourth training course for public procurers organized by Ecosistemi in Italy was held in San Giuseppe Vesuviano on March the 25th - 26th in the Campania Region.

The training mainly targeted:

- Technical Officials of neighbouring municipalities that have signed the SEAP
- External consultants of the municipality that support the activities of the SEAP
- Responsible for the administration of the municipalities of the province of Naples

15 persons attended the training held by Dana Vocino.

The introduction session has been dedicated to deepening the strategic role of green public procurement within the European policies, highlighting recent normative developments and trends of the sector. Afterwards, the session has been dedicated to the planning strategies of low carbon acquisitions.

The second day has been entirely dedicated to the theme of low carbon procurement in the construction sector, deepening the widely discussed topics of LCA and LCC for publication of CAM on Public building.

An interactive simulation exercise has been proposed in order to enable the participants to focus the organization needs and priorities. The second part of the day has been dedicated to the analysis of tenders with environmental criteria, with participants who came together to make a working group.
