

GPP 2020 aims to mainstream low-carbon public procurement across Europe in support of the European Commission's goals to achieve a 20% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions, a 20% increase in the share of renewable energy and a 20% increase in energy efficiency by 2020.



Objectives and main steps

GPP 2020 will:

- build capacity amongst public authorities for the implementation of GPP for energy related products, services and works procurement
- build capacity amongst procurement training providers, to enable the integration of GPP into regular procurement training programmes
- achieve CO₂ reductions through supporting the implementation of GPP tenders
- promote knowledge transfer of GPP approaches, and innovative technologies and services between purchasing bodies and GPP support bodies across Europe
- enhance permanent GPP support structures in eight European countries



Expected impacts

GPP 2020 will significantly increase the implementation of GPP within the target countries both in the short and long terms, through a series of capacity building and major tendering actions.

- >110 GPP tenders for energy related products and services carried out, leading to estimated GHG emissions of several 100,000t CO₂e during the project.
- 13 train the trainer seminars, resulting in 130 participants able to provide GPP training for procurers.
- 36 training seminars for procurers, resulting in 540 participants better able to implement GPP within their own procurement actions.
- A series of events and conferences, both nationally and internationally.
- Permanent GPP support functions to assist public authorities in implementation during and after the project.





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Procurement for a low-carbon economy

GPP 2020 aims to mainstream low-carbon procurement across Europe in support of the EU's goals to achieve a 20% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions, a 20% increase in the share of renewable energy and a 20% increase in energy efficiency by 2020. To this end, GPP 2020 will implement more than 100 low-carbon tenders, which will directly result in substantial CO₂ savings. Moreover, GPP 2020 is running a capacity building programme that includes trainings and exchange.
